Request for enrollment process:

- A. Complete Request for Student Enrollment form.
- B. Submit one document reflecting identical current residence address from each of the following three categories:
 1. Complete BSFCS Residency Declaration form AND
 2. Provide one of the following:
 - (a) Grant Deed/Mortgage Coupon to property of residence with imprinted parent or legal guardian name and address; OR
 - (b) Current Secured Property Tax Bill with imprinted parent or legal guardian name and address indicating homeowner's exemption; OR
 - (c) Rental/Lease Agreement (original may be required). You will also need to provide the most current month's rental receipt or cancelled check and a Declaration of Residency form from Landlord; AND
 3. Provide one of the following:
 - (a) State or Federal Tax Return with current imprinted label with parent or legal guardian name and address filed within the past 12 months with W2 attached; OR
 - (b) Payroll check stub with imprinted name and address of parent or legal guardian dated within the last month.

****Copies of original documents will be made and original returned. Amount of payments and other private information may be redacted. Residence is defined as the physical address of the applicant's primary parent(s)/legal guardian(s).**
